The Parks and Recreation Commission convened in regular session on Wednesday, November 4, 2015, at 7:30 pm, in the Council Chambers, Campbell City Hall, 70 North First Street, Campbell, California.

Old Business:

1. Recap of October 29 Joint Study Session with City Council

Director Maurantonio thanked everyone for attending the study session. The Recreation team felt terrific about the meeting.

There will be an Aquatics feasibility study and playground study.

Q80 won't change usage right now. There will be some quick upgrades such as floor and paint then will work on the E wing and revisit Q wing because they don't want to put the room out of commission. Staff is still exploring the spinning room changes.

Commissioner Hughes said he thought staff was fantastic at the study session. The feasibility request for the pool was a great request. This pool has been in existence since the late 50's. The pool is completely going in the wrong direction.

Commissioner Ptaszynski asked if the school could contribute to the play structure. Maurantonio said staff is looking at grant opportunities.

Commissioner Davidson said the play structure needs to be in a public location with lots of other kids on it so Delphi student impact will be minimal. Regarding asking Delphi to contribute toward the cost, Staff needs to be reasonable about what they ask for.

Commissioner Hughes agreed with Davidson's comment and mentioned Kaboom playgrounds.

Commissioner Walker appreciated Liz Gibbon's comment regarding reframing some issues as maintenance. Getting the flooring replaced is a health issue.

Commissioner Gibson noted one Council member was surprised at the cost of a play structure. He said Director Capurso gave a great explanation. There is a lot to building play structures. There has to be a decision made regarding ages using the play structures. It would also need to be set aside from the ball fields. He tried to explain to the Council that this was a high school that the City inherited; it was not designed to be a Community Center. Maybe staff should better define what is maintenance, what is CIP, and use that to educate the Council and the public at large. He also said staff did a great job and Aaron did a great job on the pool.

Commissioner Hughes asked if there were 3 different funding sources. Director Maurantonio responded that there is Capital Improvement Project Reserves, Park in Lieu fees and grant funding.

The operating budget is the general fund. If something is a capital improvement project it has to be over \$25,000 then it competes for a place in the CIP. For this middle ground, maintenance projects that are less than \$25,000 are programmed in the operating budget.

2. Water Conservation Update

Director Capurso stated the City is at 28% savings lower than October 2013. Year to date the City is over 30% conservation. Staff will be doing some field reseeding which will take additional water.

Commissioner Walker asked if Hacienda creates a noticeable bump in the water usage. Director Capurso replied it will be negligible, putting low water use plants in, drip system, netting and bubblers. Turf is the big user.

Commissioner Davidson asked how staff determines when to reseed. Director Capurso responded that when you reseed you need a minimum temperature required for the seed to germinate. The optimal times are when you are coming out of the warm season or going into the warm season. We try to strike a balance between our field use times and the warm weather.

3. General Plan Monthly Update

Nothing to report.

New Business

1. Park Asset Management Report

Director Capurso said this is looking at the Park and Rec open space inventory. It was a Council priority to put together an asset inventory.

Our effort tonight is two-fold: one is to bring the commission up to date on the asset management program and staff would like the Commissions feedback not only on content but how the report is delivered.

Director Capurso introduced the team that put together the Park Asset report: Scott Akin from the Santa Clara Valley Water District who is here at the City from the MTEP program, Alex Mordwinow, Abel Zaragoza and Vince Huppe from the Public Works Department.

Scott Akin gave the Park Asset Management presentation.

The term asset refers to a component or feature of a parks infrastructure or facility, natural or constructed, which has a value greater than \$1,500 or is essential for performance, enables service to be provided, has an economic life greater than five years, and/or poses a liability to the City if it is allowed to deteriorate.

The amount of \$1500 was picked because that's the level of discretionary spending that staff has.

We determined that 87% of all the assets are rated good, very good or excellent. 13% are rated poor unacceptable. Many of the assets rated good are reaching the end of their useful life.

Commissioner Davidson asked if trees and turf would be considered assets. Mr. Akin responded yes, you have to look at what the replacement cost would be.

Commissioner Gibson asked if there was any discussion about compliance issues as part of the rating process. Mr. Akin responded that staff has data on compliance and will expand the rating system to include that metric.

Staff is recommending the following projects for inclusion in the 2016-2020 CIP:

- Rehabilitation of the Campbell, Fischer, Virginia and John D. Morgan tot lots and child play areas.
- Rehabilitation of the Campbell Community Center sports fields.
- Replacement of the exercise equipment area adjacent to the stadium track at the Campbell Community Center (possibly in conjunction with development of a "boot camp" facility on the south side of the stadium bleachers).
- Rehabilitation or replacement of the Campbell Park restrooms.

Commissioner Walker asked if the Par Course is an asset. Akin responded that yes it is and so is the kiosk.

Most of the equipment and facilities are over 15 years old, they are in high use, there is a lot of wear and tear and some don't comply with current health and safety regulations.

Next steps:

- Identify dedicated asset management staff

- Continue to develop the Asset Registry
- Continue to develop the conditions assessment process
- Continue development of an enhanced analysis process

Commissioner Ptaszynski asked what kind of asset is “continue to develop Hacienda recharge ponds”. Director Capurso wanted to accurately reflect the inventory and that is open space to the residents. There are a few benches out there. The water is included in this acreage.

Commissioner Davidson asked about the Adult exercise area, is the plan to replace it all, or potentially move it if the boot camp area is designated. Director Capurso stated at this point staff is not proposing plans to replace anything, it is all subject to a community process.

Commissioner Davidson said that improving grading and drainage at John D. Morgan Park would be a great investment and would make it easier to maintain. She feels that should be highlighted.

Commissioner Hughes said this was a great report. Thanks to Abel for attending the meeting tonight. He asked if there is more to present to Council. Director Capurso responded that Regina set the bar very high with her cost estimates, so we should probably have some placeholder ballpark figures.

A member of the public asked what the yellow bands are that are on some of the play equipment at the track. Commissioner Hughes said he believes they have been placed there to enhance the equipment for users.

Commissioner Gibson said good presentation and in depth look. Staff needs to address the trends the City is experiencing in the Community. This goes back to the DAAP. He’s concerned about new homes coming in and adding 6,000 people. This will overly impact the existing facilities. He’s not hearing any discussion about additional acquisition of open space. He feels this is a gross oversight by this community as a whole. This needs to be conveyed to the City Council. This is an excellent job on this report although I don’t agree with some of the scores. Measuring the usage of the parks, how was this done - on weekdays, weeknights, and weekends. He thinks there needs to be a something in the report that would educate the Council and the Planning Commission regarding the park in lieu fee. If we’re spending that on maintenance then we’re not buying land and there will be very limited growth.

Commissioner Ptaszynski asked what staff is asking of Council. Director Capurso responded that staff just wants their input on the process. He expects some discussion as Commissioner Gibson just mentioned. He agrees that the recreational needs of the City are changing. As stated in the report, staff would need to look at a plan for replacing or rehabilitating those assets that are coming to the end of their life.

Commissioner Ptaszynski asked if there is enough money in the park in lieu fund to purchase three acres if the land was available. Director Capurso stated probably not. The General Plan does say that there should be a park within walking distance from each neighborhood. There are already park deficient areas in the City.

Commissioner Davidson would like to echo what Commissioner Gibson said about looking at the larger picture. The Council or someone needs to figure out what to do with this daytime population that will

be coming in with the DAAP. The City is ill equipped for population growth whether it's daytime or people living here.

Commissioner Hughes agrees along those lines. There are some large residential structures going up. The City has deficiencies in parks and fields right now. When those units come on line the City is going to have deficiencies all the time. There is nobody that can get on the Campbell fields now because they are completely over programmed. Staff really needs to make sure that somebody figures this out.

Commissioner Gibson asked what the City's policy is regarding working with the school districts to utilize more of their space. Director Capurso said he does not know of a formal policy but there are some goals in the General Plan to work with other agencies to use their space. That may be a better way to go rather than purchasing land.

Commissioner Hughes stated the sports leagues have to go to the school districts on their own the negotiate use of their fields. It's a very slow tedious process to get to use their facilities.

2. November 7th Parks Tour

Director Capurso stated staff was trying to line up the parks tour with the volunteer day for John D. Morgan Park. Since there was a lack of Commissioners available for the Parks tour it was determined to invite the Commissioners to attend the park cleanup at John D. Morgan Park at 9:00 a.m. Hughes and Walker will attend the volunteer clean up.

Committee Reports:

Parks and Creek Trail: Commissioner Gibson said it appears there are some drug paraphernalia problems at Virginia Park. He'd be interested in knowing about the park maintenance practices over there and also if there is a way of getting this on the parks police patrol. One report said they saw the maintenance crew leaving and then found a crack pipe in the children's play area. Other than that parks look pretty good. Staff is doing a good job managing the water. Director Capurso will talk to Police and Maintenance regarding the drug issue. Commissioner Walker said she's noticed issues on the Creek Trail, has had items stolen from her porch. She also noticed there is some dead grass on the berm at John D. Morgan Park. Director Capurso will look into it.

Trees: No Report.

Special Events: Commissioner Hughes said the pre-registration the night before the race felt fairly slow. He asked to hear from Commissioners regarding registration on race day. Commissioner Ptaszynski said the Friday night thing was so successful there were more than enough people at the table to help out on race day. Director Maurantonio said that the race went extremely well. They got a lot of nice compliments from the community, people loved the T-shirts. It was a very strong event. Commissioner Ptaszynski mentioned that the last medals given out were to the older people. Perhaps that should be done earlier. Director Capurso attended both days and said he could vouch for Hughes giving out shirts and for Commissioner Ptaszynski standing around with nothing to do.

Recreation Plan Subcommittee: Already covered.

Staff Reports:

Work Plan Updates – Director Maurantonio

- Youth Commission – is working very hard, they are meeting twice a month because they have so much to do. Their next meeting is Monday night at 7:00 p.m. at the Community Center in either the Q building or OCBH. Commissioner Hughes asked if they could come address the Parks and Rec Commission at some point. Director Maurantonio said yes, she would look into that.

Parks: Todd Capurso

- The over seeding project will begin the week of November 4th so staff will be moving through some sports fields, putting up some fencing to keep people off some areas that need more treatment.
- Commercial Tree Company will be installing the Christmas lights at the Community Center and Orchard City Green.
- Staff is working with other agencies to cleanup a homeless encampment close to Rolling Hills Middle School.
- The Santa Clara Valley Water District well project is pending revisions of the project layout. They are now looking at an area near the edge of the parking lot. The project would take up about 25 parking spaces for 8 to 10 weeks.
- Ten new trees will be planted at Campbell Park in the next two weeks.
- The Virginia Park slide has been replaced.
- The Park Asset Management Report will be presented at a study session on Tuesday Nov. 17th.
- Staff is targeting Tuesday, Nov. 24 as the official opening of the Hacienda Avenue Green Street Project.

Recreation and Community Services: Director Maurantonio

- Last Friday night at the Museum there was a small successful event for children for Halloween called “Spooky Night at the Museum.”
- Director Maurantonio asked the Commissioners if they would like to get together for a holiday dinner this year. The Commissioners said yes, they would, Wednesday, Dec. 9th at 6:30 p.m. would work for all. The restaurant chosen was Sorelle’s.

Police Report

Information only.

Commissioner Gibson mentioned the brandishing of a weapon and battery at John D. Morgan Park, and wondered if anyone knew anything about it. Sept. 15 at Los Gatos Creek Trail there was a laser strike and he wondered what that was about. Staff will check into this.

Good of the Game

Commissioner Johnson - The Commissioners Dinner was great, good format, great food. Also wanted to commend staff for the tour they did at the Recreation Plan study session. You could see the staff's passion and commitment.

Commissioner Hughes congratulated Commissioner Davidson and Regina for graduating from Leadership California. Excellent job with the study session and he thinks the asset management plan is fantastic and he will borrow some of this for his soccer league. He said he went to a Commissioners training his first year on the commission and he was surprised at how much infighting there was. It's very commendable and inspiring to see how everyone here is on the same page. Hats off to everyone.

Commissioner Ptaszynski – During the study session he talked to a couple of staff members, complimenting what you just said about the whole organization and they pretty much said it's all because of Regina.


