The website content needs to be outlined now; sub-committee to work on building the frame work in advance of the “work party.” Commissioners encouraged to think of creative domain name.
 - c. Arts festival – Students in CUHSD and CUSD will be encouraged to participate in photo/art project to help build the image of the teen resource website. A flyer with this information needs to be created by 4/1. Images should include, but not limited to, Campbell landmarks, parks, and downtown with and without teens. Sub-committee is also interested in hosting an Open Mic night at Orchard Valley Coffee or Snake and Butterfly. Commissioners will visit business this week to ask permission before further planning.
