MEASURE A & B SUPPORT

Join us, the Campbell Village Neighborhood Association, and the City of Campbell, in supporting our neighborhood's annexation into Campbell by voting yes on Measures A and B.

The Neighborhood's grassroots effort to annex into the City of Campbell was successful after years of hard work, unwavering commitment and money. We fought to become part of Campbell for many reasons: community identity, responsive emergency and city services and better representation.

Voting yes on Measures A and B create a new revenue source for Campbell to help fund services for our Neighborhood through the Community Facilities District. The new funds will be used to provide Fire, Police, EMS services, flood and storm protection, street maintenance and recreation programs.

Campbell has supported and worked with us since the beginning of the annexation process. They spent tens of thousands of dollars on the annexation effort. A condition of the annexation requires Campbell to transfer a large portion of the area's revenues to San Jose. Without CFD funding this transfer of funds may negatively affect services to our area.

Measure B's fixed cost is still significantly less than the higher total costs we would have paid to the City of San Jose had the neighborhood not been annexed into Campbell. Campbell will stop levying the special tax in 2053-2054.

It is important to vote Yes on both Measures. Voting yes on Measures A and B will be a significant step towards securing the safety and quality of life in our neighborhood. Campbell has been a true partner, and now they are asking for us to support them and our Neighborhood by approving both Measures.
