## SF MUSEUM OF MODERN ART

After 3 long years of renovation SFMOMA reopened as the largest museum of its kind in the U.S. The stand-alone 10-story architectural statement rises over Moscone Center and the Yerba Buena Gardens. Our guided tour will cover the highlights of the SFMOMA collection. After the tour you will have time on your own to explore over 460,000 square feet of museum exhibits. Special exhibits include: Model Behavior, Alexander Calder – Motion Lab and British Sculptors – The Fisher Collection.
